

ART ON NAILS MORE THAN 2 INCHES LONG

Theme: International Sporting Events - One hand / 5 nails

JUDGE 1

Overall Look - Structure

Has this set got a structural WOW factor – assess the complexity of the nail structures, shape, form & architecture. (20pts)

Length

The length of the nail is more than 2"inches from the cuticle on all 5 nails and appears uniform on all 5 – even if shapes may vary. (20pts)

JUDGE 2

Nail Shapes

The shapes showcased across the hand are strong, uniform and consistent with the styling expected from the shape chosen on each finger. Is this skilled & thorough work? (20pts)

Complexity

Assess the complexity of the nail sculpting. (20pts)

JUDGE 3

Free Edge Thickness

Nails must be consistently thin throughout. (10pts)

Product Control

Even application of product, no shadows, no air bubbles or pits. (20pts)

JUDGE 4

Surface Smoothness

Where there is no raised artwork, the nail has no file line or demarcations; it is smooth with no bumps, dips, rough or dull spots. (10pts)

Cuticle Area

No cuts or irritation around the skin. Clean, flawless cuticle area. (10pts)

Originality

Depth & dimension of the design. It is original? Evaluate the complexity of these designs. (20pts)

JUDGE 5

Overall Look - Art

Has this set got artistic WOW factor – assess the artforms that are encapsulated, on the surface or raised. (20pts)

Creativity

Are you seeing creative use of art media & techniques? How well does the design fit the theme? (20pts)

Finish Work

There should not be any scratches in the paint or product application. Is the cuticle clean & the entire nail capped in sealer with a high gloss look & are the nails clear of any dust or debris & rough edges etc? (20pts)

Total Score out of 210pts

1 - Unacceptable

2 - Not quite a 1, but still needs a lot of work

3 - Below average skill level

4 to 5 - Average skill level

6 to 7 - Above average skill level

8 - Very good, well on the way to a winning technique

9 - Virtually flawless, excellent skill

10 - Flawless in every way, no improvement possible
